Greetings.

I recently had the opportunity to speak to pastors and leaders at the Baptist Union Assembly about the DBC Life Trust. Our focus is on supporting retired Baptist pastors living with desperate needs. My mandate from the trustees was threefold:

- Express gratitude to churches and individuals who have supported the trust since 2008.
- Invite potential new donors to consider giving.
- Identify pensioners within our denomination who require assistance.

During my meetings with churches, leaders, and individuals, I was able to thank them for their contributions, which have made a significant difference in the lives of 68 retired pastors and their spouses. Most of these individuals rely on a government grant and the R1000 monthly stipend we provide.

I also challenged people to continue supporting this cause. As a result of my meetings, we've identified 20 additional couples/individuals in need, requiring an additional R20,000 per month. To address this growing need, I'd like to share ways you can get involved.
